There are many different species of sharks that range in size from the size of a person's hand to bigger than a bus. The biggest shark is the Whale shark, which can be up to 46 feet (14 m) long. The smallest shark is the Spined Pygmy shark, which, when fully-grown, is only 7-8 inches (18-20 cm) long. Most sharks are intermediate in size, about the same size as people, 5-7 feet (1.5-2.1 m) long.
