Origins of the Role Play Technique “Role play is a technique used by counselors of different theoretical orientations with clients who need to develop a deeper understanding of, or change within, themselves (James & Gilliland, 2003). Within a role play, clients can perform a decided-upon behavior in a safe, risk-free environment.

Role Play - Counseling Practices

Role playing is experienced-based and requires minimal support material outside the initial problem situation. Role playing is designed explicitly to nurture: 1) the examination of personal values and behavior; 2) the development of strategies for solving interpersonal and personal problems; and 3) the development of empathy towards others.

Role-playing happens when two or more people act out roles in a particular scenario. It's most useful for helping you prepare for unfamiliar or difficult situations. You can also use it to spark brainstorming sessions, improve communication between team members, and see problems or situations from different perspectives.
